
We will have a sign up a sheet for refreshments at the Membership table at our General Membership Meetings or you can email Toni Walker at toni, walker 58@yahoo.com.

Orchid Tip of the Month by Scott Mitamura:

Our annual orchid show marks the arrival of spring and with it the arrival of many flowering orchids. Our mild winter this year caused many of our flowers to bloom early and it already seems like summer weather. With the sunny days the orchids are rapidly growing so make sure they are getting enough water and fertilizer. Hono honos are in full bloom, with the Nestor's and little sweet scents to follow. Treat them as needed for flower thrips (browning/drying of the young buds). Try to keep the water off the flowers to discourage Botrytis (brown spotting on flowers) and to extend the flower life. Phalaenopsis are also in full bloom. Stake the flower spikes to keep the flowers up, bring them indoors to enjoy them, but keep the water out of their leaf whorl to avoid crown rot. Now that the show is over, and I brought back my orchids to my greenhouse, I watered them and sprayed insecticide on them to avoid bringing back any unwanted bugs. This goes for orchids that I have purchased too! In addition, I would treat them for slugs, I would also make sure that they don't have weeds, and I would often repot them into my own media. An ounce of prevention will save you a lot of trouble in the long run.
