Orchid Tip of the Month by Scott Mitamura:

Our Hawaiian Winter is officially here. During our cooler shorter days, our challenge is to keep our orchids from getting too much water. Fertilizing can be kept to a minimum, most orchids are not very hungry when they are not actively growing. Hono Hono orchids should be kept dry to allowing to rest up for flowering. If you are doing a good job, your leaves should be turning yellow and falling. Phalaenopsis should be spiking, so keep them aligned to your main source of light. Avoid moving or turning them, this will give you the best chance of a even arrangement of flowers.
