## **Orchid Tip of the Month by Scott Mitamura:**

Although it is still winter our shortest days are behind us. Still keep a close tab on your watering, keeping your orchids on the dryer side. The early blooming Hono Hono dendrobiums should begin to start showing buds this month. It is a critical time for them as the flower thrips love to attack the tender buds. It would be a good idea to spray them with any insecticide before they start to dry up. It is not too early to think about which orchids might be blooming for the Spring Show and begin grooming them early. We will have a large display and will need everyone to bring their best orchids out to the show.
