15th - 23rd February, 2014 | at the Tokyo Dome, Tokyo Japan Grand Prix International Orchid Festival at the Tokyo Dome features 80,000 orchids from 24 countries. The 3,000 species on display represent 10 percent of the world's orchid species. Tickets cost about \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2}\),000 at the door. The events draws large crowds. There are competitions for the best orchid in several different classes, an "Orchid Fantasy of Light" show, lectures and instructions on growing orchids and over 150 tables and booths with orchids and orchid-growing gear for sale.





Orchid Tip of the Month by Scott Mitamura:

September puts us in the middle of our hurricane season. Prior to any storm take down all hanging orchids and put them in a safe place. Preferably not on the ground, where soil born pathogens (slugs, fungus, bacteria, nematodes, etc.) may infect the orchid. Also, secure all other objects that could get picked up in the wind. Storms (and helpful grand children), are a good reason to use a hole punch on all labels and wire them to the orchids. This way if the orchid gets separated from the pot, the label won't be separated from the orchid. All labels are best written with a #2 lead pencil, even if the orchid came with a printed label. Printed labels will eventually fail, so it is good practice to have a second label.
