Orchid Tip of the Month by Scott Mitamura:

Well we lucked out and dodged another storm. But wet humid weather has arrived this fall. Our biggest challenge is to allow our orchids to dry between waterings or rainstorms. Orchids will dry faster if given good air circulation, so try to not overcrowd your plants, raise them higher above the ground if possible, and keep them staked and well groomed. Keep your areas around your orchids clear. As soon as you see a fungal infection separate the plant, keep it dry, and remove the affected part of the plant. Of course, always sterilize your pruners. Fungal infections are easily spread by dirty potting tools and splashing water. Also, with the wet weather the hungry slugs will go on the attack! Apply any slug bait to get them before they get to your orchids.

If you don't have enough orchids flowering, you must attend our annual auction night! You will have your chance to acquire some great orchids from many of our top nurseries from Oahu and the Big Island, many of them at wholesale prices! It promises to be a fun night!
