Orchid Tip of the Month by Scot Mitamura:

TOTAL ATTENDING:____

We are having great spring weather and it already seems like summer. Because of the dry sunny days and many of the fragrant flowers like gardenias are in bloom, we are seeing thrip damage to the Hono Hono (browning and curling of the new leaves in the whorl). Also, cattleya flowers may be showing brown edges. Treat with any insecticide or rubbing alcohol, increase watering, and pick up dead flowers and leaves.
