#### **Orchid Tip of the Month by Scot Mitamura:**

With the warm weather, it seems like summer is already here, but actuality summer begins on June 21. The National Weather Service is predicting an El Nino event this year, so be prepared for a long hot summer. This can be good for our orchids. They should be actively growing, with many of them initiating new growths and roots, thus re-potting is a major focus during the summer months. Increase your watering intervals and foliar fertilize your orchids often. Maintain good air circulation to avoid sunburn and insect infestations. Flower thrips and spider mites are normal problems during dry periods, so keep an eye out for brown edges of your flowers and a silvering of the undersides of your leaves.

Make sure you attend our Installation/Awards banquet this month. We are bringing in orchids for various nurseries from around the state, so it will be a great chance to add some beautiful orchids to your collection. It will be a fun affair!
