

Orchid Tip of the Month by Scot Mitamura

Since summer is a time for repotting, I would like to remind everyone to sterilize their pruners. They are often attributed to the spread of viruses and other diseases such as fungus and bacteria. The best way to sterilize them is by heating them with a self igniting propane torch. Other methods may be a barbecue lighter or dipping them into a 10% bleach solution.

Your pots, if reused, should also be soaked in the bleach solution with all the white roots being scrubbed off. Anything that is reused should be sterilized by either method. If you haven't been practicing this, it would be a good time to start. We are finding that orchid viruses are not only spread from one orchid to a other, but are spread from other plant species as well.
