Orchid Tip of the Month by Scot Mitamura

Summer is here and we are already getting record breaking high temperatures. We are not the only ones feeling it, our orchids feel it too. When it gets too warm, the orchid's metabolism will shut down and in extreme cases, the cells in the leaves will rupture and burn. This really hinders growth and flowering, and sometimes will stress the orchid so much that it dies.

The easy solution is to move the orchid into a shadier location in your yard, but not too shady. Orchids need a good source of sunlight to grow and flower. Rebecca Northern says, "give your orchids the maximum amount of light just short of burning".

It is common to only adjust the sunlight on the orchid, but we often forget that there are other factors that will allow your orchid to handle more sunlight. Having good air movement around your orchids is not only essential for healthy orchids, but you can grow them in a much brighter sunlight. The more sunlight you give the orchid the more it can grow and flower.

Watering during the morning or during the hottest time of the day will also greatly cool your orchids as the water evaporates.

So let's take advantage of our hot summer days and water and fertilize our orchids, so they can grow big and strong and reward us an abundance of flowers.
