Orchid Tip of the Month by Scot Mitamura

August brings us into the middle of our warm summer months. Like ourselves, we need our orchids to be well hydrated and fertilized. Be mindful about dry weather pests. Dried out flower spikes could mean flower thrips. Grey to brown markings under the leaves could be spider mites. Keep growing areas tidy, and in both cases spray with isopropyl alcohol and rub the infected areas, or spray with Bayer 3n1.

Also, get prepared for possible hurricanes. Put away all loose objects, and lower hanging orchids. From previous bad storm experiences, I now use a whole punch and I wire my labels to my orchids.

Hopefully we and our orchids can luckily survive another hurricane season.
