Orchid Tip of the Month

Winter is here, so adjust your watering schedules. It is really important to allow your orchids to dry between waterings. For Hono Honos, remember after Thanksgiving, we should withhold fertilizer and keep them dry. It is a good sign to see the leaves begin to yellow and fall, as they want to go dormant for two months. In February we should see buds beginning to form.
