Best Other Color Cattleya: Lc. Aquii-Finn 'St. Shirley' AM/AOS, Scot & Karen Mitamura

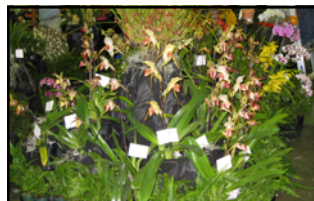
Best of Yellow Dendrobium: Den. aggregatum, Ed Catrett

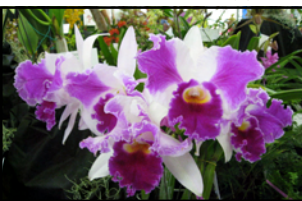

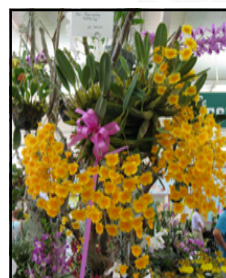
