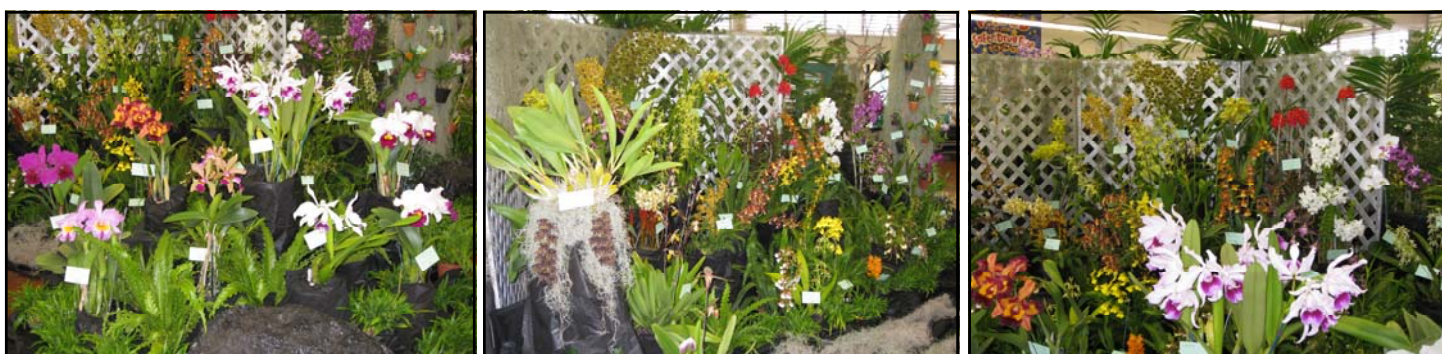
Best Lavender Cattleya: *Laelia purpurata*, Owner Walter Hiraishi
