### "ORGANIC" Orchid Gardening

**Guest Speaker: Robert Speer** 

Our featured speaker for May is President of the Master Gardener Association and teaches a "Master Gardeners" class at U.H. Bob will discuss some of the details of orchid culturing and using organic techniques, including making compost tea (various inexpensive methods). # Orchid Tip of the Month By Adam Kono

I am no expert when it comes to orchid culture that's why I hang around those who are. Listening to their advice when it comes to orchid culture will save you a lot of heartache and dead orchids! So my advice is do yourself a favor and keep coming to the meetings to hear what they have to say.

Additional Information from April's speaker Sheron's Presention on "ABC's of Orchids"

A question was asked about watering – since I started out the watering portion mentioning that the quickest way to kill an orchid is to water it. I also mentioned to check with a pencil or chopstick the 'center' of the pot. If you test and the pencil comes out 'wet' don't water. If it's dry then water. The thing to remember is "when in doubt, don't water". I also discussed how in my greenhouse I either water every day or it rains, either way I my plants are getting WATER every day!!! REMEMBER we discussed lots of things -Air circulation; light as well as media. SO in my greenhouse I have all my plants in a type of fast draining/drying media that allows me to water/rain every day. If proper cultural requirements are kept; if you use the right media; if your plants are healthy - you CAN water every day!
