

Plants Given out at the October Meeting

If you received the plant labeled Blc. Tribute 'ID' x Bc. Donna Kimura 'PT'. The entire name of the plant is Blc. Tribute 'Independence Day' x Bc. Donna Kimura 'Paradise Tami'. Both parents of this plant are large, excellent shaped light lavenders and should bloom in the fall.

If you received the other plant, you got a Lc. Melody Fair 'Carol' x C. Horace 'Maxima'. The flower should be well shaped light lavenders with purple lips. There may be even a few whites with purple lips. Blooming season will be in the winter.

The care for these plants should be: keep them under partial shade, let them dry slightly between waterings, repotting can be done at any time, but avoid repotting during rainy weather and fertilize with either a timed release or water soluable type of fertilizer. Both of these plants are about two to three years from blooming.


