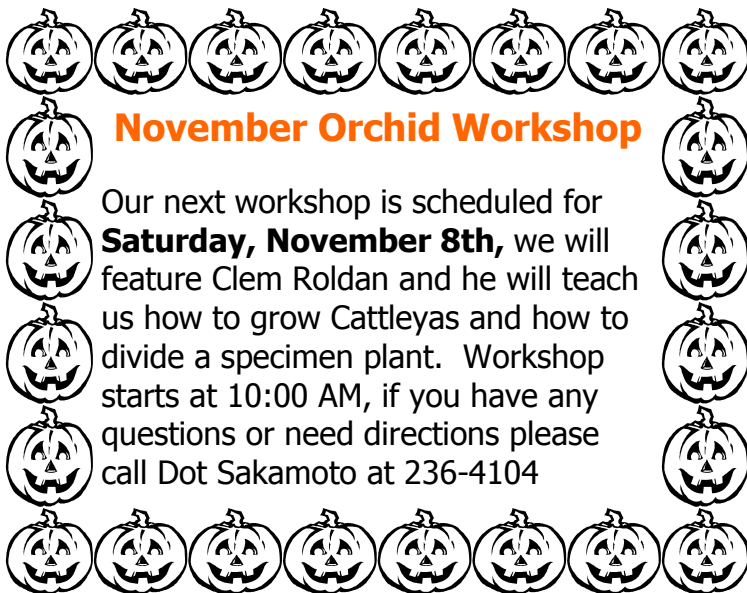
MAHALO
