# Growing a Specimen Plant "Aka Monster Plant" by Roy Tokunaga

Did you ever go to an orchid show and see a "Monster" specimen orchid plant and wonder how many years it took to grow it.? Well you're in luck, we were very, fortunate to secure Mr. Roy Tokunaga as our featured speaker for the October WOS meeting. It just so happens to be one of his many talents and he will give you some pointers on growing a "MONSTER SPECIMEN" plant. He is a graduate from the University of Hawaii in 1973, with a bachelors in education (high school biology). Never got to teach as he was recruited by Ernest Iwanaga to start an orchid lab. He spent his first 7 years cloning and germinating orchids. He left in 1981 to start up H&R Nurseries in Waimanalo with Harry Akagi. He is an accredited AOS judge and has been hybridizing for about 30 years with several thousand hybrids delivered. Most of his work has been hybridizing Dendrobium and Cattleya Alliance.
