SPEAKER OF THE MONTH: Sheron Harwood on general orchid culture with a twist!

Sheron is our Treasurer. She gave a general orchid culture workshop at the WOS's Valentine's Day Show at the Windward Mall on February 14, 15 & 16, 2014. Many volunteers showed up to help promote our March Show. We gave away hundreds of tickets to our show, while telling folks all about our club. Sheron gave a general orchid culture workshop each of the three days at 1 p.m. Just look at her huge audience!



Before Sheron talks about general orchid culture, we will introduce Christy Martin, a University of Hawaii Public Information Officer, who will give us a talk on the Little Fire Ant. Stinging ants that are new to Hawaii, and spreading, they infest yards and agricultural fields, and will move into houses. They cause pain, welts and intense itching that lasts.

Orchid Tip of the Month by Scott Mitamura:

The days are getting longer and the sunlight stronger as we reach Spring on March 20. We still need to be cautious about our watering, as March can be still be a rainy month for us. With our winter behind us, we should begin to see more activity with our orchids. Phalaenopsis should be in full bloom, and Hono honos should be showing buds. Once the buds are showing you can start watering them again. Watch and treat for flower thrips, as they often feed on the young buds turning them brown. Start selecting and prepping your orchids for the show. Set up is on Thursday March 20; what a way to kick of our spring season!
